The Gardiner Museum celebrates the art of ceramics and engages local and international audiences by promoting understanding of the long history of people crafting in clay. Through the display of its permanent collections and special exhibitions, as well as through studio education, programs that engage diverse communities, and major contributions to scholarship, the Gardiner champions ceramics. The Gardiner Museum is among the few museums in the world focused on ceramics, and is one of the most important specialty museums internationally.

The Family Sunday facilitator will work with the Education department to successfully implement Family Sunday programming. In this role, the facilitator will oversee tile painting sessions biweekly, working alongside volunteers to engage with visitors and to establish connections between themes and the Gardiner Museum collection and exhibitions.

Duties

- Implements bi-weekly Family Sunday programming and occasional other days as needed
- Engages with visitors and communicates programming themes
- Works with volunteers to assist participants with tile painting,
- Works with volunteers with set up, and clean-up of studio
- Tracks attendance and gathers feedback from visitors
- Attends monthly meetings and general training sessions

Requirements

- Excellent customer service skills
- Experience in formal or informal education
- Comfortable working with children and families
- Must have a background in fine arts and the ability to provide technical assistance
- Ability to work as a team, with shifting roles and responsibilities.
