Camp sizes

Morning Summer Clay Camp and Full Day Art Camp sessions have a maximum of 12 campers. Youth Wheel Summer Workshops have a maximum of 10 campers.

Drop off and Pick Up

Morning and full day campers can be dropped off starting at 8:30 am (9 am start). Afternoon campers can be dropped off starting at 12:45 pm (1 pm start). We don't offer extended care. Please sign in with your child's camp counsellor each day.

Full Day Art Camp: 4 pm

Youth Wheel Summer Workshop: 4 pm

Please wait for you camper in the museum lobby.

If your child is allowed to leave on their own, please remind them that they still need to sign in and out with their camp counsellor.

Please bring valid Photo ID: Campers will only be released to a designated parent/guardian or other authorized adult listed on the registration form.

Arrival on First Day of Camp

Morning Summer Clay Camp and Full Day Art Camp can be dropped off between 8:30 - 9am. Children will be in a supervised play area inside the Museum prior to the start of camp.

Youth Wheel Summer Workshop camper should arrive between 12:45 - 1 pm.

Please enter through our front doors and sign in with the camp counsellor. Please bring in all registration forms filled out on the first day of camp.

Camper absences or late arrival

If your child is ill, arriving late, leaving early, or away for any other reason, please contact us at 416.586.8080. If there is no answer, please leave a message.

Snacks and Lunch

Snacks and lunches are not provided. Campers are asked to bring snacks (all campers) and lunch (full day campers) with them everyday. There will be scheduled breaks.

Please note: While we cannot guarantee a nut-free camp as the space is shared daily, please assist us by ensuring that your child's lunch is nut-free and that campers do not bring food to share with others. Campers will not have access to a refrigerator or microwave. Campers are not permitted to go off-site to purchase lunch.

What to bring and wear:

- Snacks (all campers) and lunch (full day camp)
- Sunscreen. Please make sure you apply sunscreen before camp.
- Water in a refillable water bottle labelled with the camper's name.
- Clothes that can get dirty.
- Closed-toe shoes (no flip flops or sandals)
- Bathing suit, towel, water shoes, and a bag to store these items when wet (only for full day campers on Thursdays.)
